Suicide prevention charity Campaign Against Living Miserably (CALM) unveils its Missing Birthdays installation at Westfield White City in London. The installation, which is made up of 6,929 balloons each representing a young life lost to suicide, follows a new report by CALM, stating that only 15 per cent of parents and carers have discussed the topic of suicide with young adults in their care. To help combat this, the charity is launching the CALM C.A.R.E kit, a free online resource that provides practical tools and

suggestions for approaching discussions about suicide.
